

Cork's reign as European capital of culture 2005 was assisted by the dearth of architecture that popped up on the Leeside that year. Wain Morehead Architects completed several projects around the city, including a high spec modern office fit-out for G J Moloney & Co., Solicitors at the City Quarter, Lapps Quay and a new build dwelling on the Marina with the focus on energy efficiency and accessibility.

Established in 1995, the practice is headed up by John Morehead and provides expertise in the architectural, interior design, urban planning and project management areas.

Two of the practice's major urban design projects have started on site recently. The regeneration of the Knockneheeny area which was nominated for the grand prix urban design of Europe is well underway and involves the refurbishment of housing stock, redefinition of public realm and provision of a range of community facilities whereas the Stag park project involves the extension of the planned town of Mitchelstown.
